The result is stylistically distinct expressions of this variety that burst with zesty fruit intensity and refined mineral elegance.

O:TU Sauvignon Blanc 2009 —
Winemaker Gordon Ritchie's tasting notes:

AROMA - Classic Marlborough varietal of freshly mown grass, with some white flowers - blossom, lime and grapefruit pith. Minerals characters of slate and flint are evident with a touch of powder or talc.

PALATE - The palate is fresh and bright with ripe zingy acid. There are lime, chalky and mineral flavours with good texture leading to a long finish, typical of this style of wine from the Awatere Valley.
